Baptism for Infants and Preschool Children under 7 years old

At Baptism, infants and preschool children are initiated into the Christian community and begin a life-long journey as a committed disciple of Christ. Since the child cannot make this commitment on their own, the parent who requests Baptism states that they wish to pass on the faith in which they believe and live. Parents wishing to have their infant or preschooler Baptized are required to attend Baptism Preparation. This gives them the opportunity to reflect on the meaning of Baptism and to have their questions answered concerning the Sacrament of Baptism and the ceremony. Sixth Sunday In Ordinary Time

Sirach 15:15-20

Psalms 119

1Corinthians 2:6-10

Matthew 5:17-37

Living Moral Life Naturally

The opening lines of the first reading from the Book of Sirach say, "If you choose you can keep the commandments, they will save you; if you trust in God, you too shall live...."

To "choose" as spoken of in Sirach implies morality. Morality is based on God's revelation and God's action. Thus, we look to Scripture, Tradition and Magisterium of the Church to guide us. They are known as the Three Fonts of the Truth. Through these Three Fonts of the Truth we discern authentic teaching as the Lord reveals it to us. Also, it is recommended to seek wise counsel to ensure proper interpretation of the Truth.

Once we discern the authentic teaching, we take the next step. We trust in it. God's Word is reliable. The Lord does not lead us astray. That is not God's intent, ever. God leads us to wholeness and fulfillment.

The next step is to act on the teaching that is received from the Lord, if some action is called for. Action, in this case, is not necessarily executing some physical act. It might be accepting a Truth that is revealed.

When we speak of discernment, we mean becoming aware of the guidance that leads to the teaching. Discernment is not making a decision. It is what an eventual decision may be based on. Then, when we have all the information, wisdom is applied.

Wisdom is applying the information to insight. That is, knowing the inner qualities and relationships that apply to given situations. Further, wisdom involves good sense or judgment that comes about through accumulated knowledge that is learned over time.

Note what St. Paul writes in 1 Corinthians. He speaks of God's wisdom. "What eye has not seen, and ear has not heard, and what has not entered the human heart, what God has prepared for those who love him, this God has revealed to us through the Spirit."

In today's gospel passage, Jesus reaches to the greatest depth of knowledge and discernment. He takes the law of God and moves it beyond something that is perfunctory, something that merely keeps civil order.

Jesus brings us to see what the basis for all our actions is. The law is based on internal disposition. Deep down in our very soul is found what ought to be

the motive of all human actions. It is a rigorous integrity based on the wholeness of God.

God's wholeness is manifested in fullness and fulfillment of life. It is coming to recognize we all come from the divine image that we have been made in. That is, God's own image. From this comes what makes moral life not just following a law but living it naturally.

Over time, living according to the Lord's guidance found in Scripture, Tradition and Magisterium, the moral life becomes more natural. Fullness of life becomes noticeable and fulfilling.
