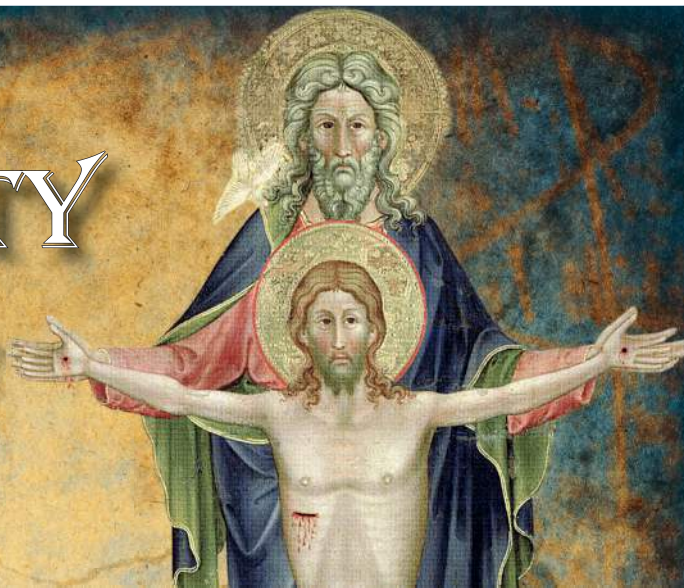

Baptism for Infants and Preschool Children under 7 years old

At Baptism, infants and preschool children are initiated into the Christian community and begin a life-long journey as a committed disciple of Christ. Since the child cannot make this commitment on their own, the parent who requests Baptism states that they wish to pass on the faith in which they believe and live. Parents wishing to have their infant or preschooler Baptized are required to attend Baptism Preparation. This gives them the opportunity to reflect on the meaning of Baptism and to have their questions answered concerning the Sacrament of Baptism and the ceremony. In order to begin preparing for their child's Baptism, parents are asked to contact the parish office at 954-564-1010 prior to the anticipated birth or adoption process. Unity in Mercy, Grace, Kindness and Fidelity

"Thus the Lord passed before him (Moses) and cried out, 'The Lord, the Lord, a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity.'" (Ex. 34)

God declares himself to be merciful and gracious. This declaration comes relatively early in God's manifestation of himself in our history of salvation. His mercy and salvation are shown to us repeatedly throughout time. Thus, it must be that he is merciful and gracious.

Today's response from Daniel 3 repeatedly reminds us God is praiseworthy and exalted above all forever. Humankind has come to note this. God is awesome. He is way beyond our imagination when it comes to the creative power of love.

Today's passage from John's Gospel points out Jesus' purpose was to bring salvation. It says, "...So that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." It also points out that not putting faith in Jesus leads to condemnation. This condemnation, however, does not come as God's wish for us. It comes as a natural logical consequence of our own choice evidenced in our own behavior.

If you do not believe in God and his way, you take yourself out of the path of salvation. God the Son makes present and concrete God the Father's love as seen in His incarnation. Recognizing this, why would anyone turn away from Jesus? Would we not want to be connected to the source of all Love? In tasting the unity with the Lord, the draw of that encounter is so powerful that it is difficult to turn away from it. This brings us back to the first reading, Exodus 34.

This scene recalls how when Moses was up on the mountain receiving the Ten Commandments from God, the people waiting down below turned their backs on God. Impatience prevailed.

Unknown to Moses, the people had made themselves a statue of a Golden Calf. They worshiped it. This was an insult to God, and it was highly disobedient. Moses discovered this as he came down the mountain with the tablets of the Ten Commandments. In anger Moses broke the tablets. God let Moses express his

anger. It was justified. Yet, God wants Moses to work with justice and mercy.

God models to Moses how to act as a godly person. By extension, this is the model all people are to follow. God is rich in kindness and fidelity. These attributes are signs of a father's love. It is a love that is unmerited. It is a gift that comes from a father that has gifts to give. Further, he wills to give the gift, Love. The kindness is a sign of the contract God makes with his people. Finally, fidelity is God's absolute dedication and faithfulness to us, His people. His will is to always love us.

In this holy love, the three persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit are bonded together. They are Unity itself. They are of one nature, Love. It is a love that is expressed in three persons. In this unity, mercy, grace, kindness and fidelity are expressed.

May we the human race find unity among us. First, let each of us as an individual repent and find peace with God. Then, as an expression of our relationship with God, let us employ the Godly attributes of mercy, grace, kindness and fidelity.
